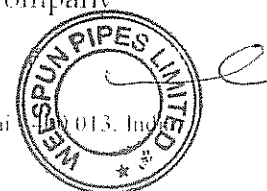

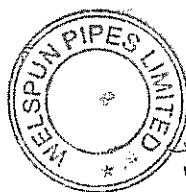

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Members of Welspun Pipes Limited

Report on the Financial Statements

1. We have audited the accompanying financial statement of **Welspun Pipes Limited** ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2014, the Statement of Profit and Loss and Cash Flow Statement for the year then ended, and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information, which we have signed under reference to this report.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

2. The Company's Management is responsible for the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance and cash flows of the Company in accordance with the Accounting Standards notified under the Companies Act, 1956 ("the Act"), read with the General Circular 15/2013 dated 13th September 2013 of the Ministry of corporate Affairs in respect of Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013. This responsibility includes the design, implementation and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

3. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirement and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Company's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

- (c) in the case of the Cash Flow Statement, of the cash flows for the year ended on that date.

Statement referred to in paragraph (5) of our report of even date to the members of Welspun Pipes Limited on the accounts for the year ended 31st March, 2014

1. (a) The Company is maintaining proper records showing full particulars, including quantitative details and situation of fixed assets.
- (b) According to information and explanation given to us, there are no assets apart from Leasehold Land. Hence, question of its verification and material discrepancies does not arise.
- (c) In our opinion and according to the information and explanation given to us, a substantial part of the fixed assets has been disposed of during the year. However, such disposal has not affected the going concern status of the Company.
2. The Company did not have any inventories. Hence, the question of physical verification and records thereof does not arise.
3. (a) The Company has not granted any loans, secured or unsecured, to any company, firm or other parties covered in the register maintained under section 301 of the Act. As such, the requirements regarding the quantum of amount of loan, rate of interest, repayment of principal and interest and overdue amounts are not applicable.
- (b) The Company has not taken any secured / unsecured loans from any company, firm or other parties covered in the register maintained under Section 301 of the Act. As such, the requirements regarding the quantum of amount of loan, rate of interest, repayment of principal and interest are not applicable.
4. In our opinion and according to the information and explanations given to us, there is an adequate internal control system commensurate with size of the company and the nature of its business with regard to purchase of fixed assets. During the course of our audit, no major weaknesses were noticed in the internal control system in respect of above areas.
5. According to the information and explanation given to us, there is no contract or arrangement the particulars of which are required to be entered into the register in pursuance of section 301 of the Act.
6. The Company has not accepted any deposit from the Public within the meaning of Section 58A and 58AA of the Act and the rules framed thereunder.
7. The Company is not a listed or other company having a paid-up capital and reserves exceeding Rs 50 lacs as at the commencement of the financial year or having an average annual turnover exceeding Rs 5 Crores for a period of three consecutive financial year immediately preceding the financial year concerned. Therefore the Company is exempt from the requirement of an internal audit system.
8. The Central Government has not prescribed maintenance of cost records under section 209 (1) (d) of the Companies Act, 1956 for the company.
9. (a) According to information and explanation given to us and records of the company examined by us, the Company has been regular in depositing undisputed statutory dues, including, Income Tax, and other material statutory dues, as applicable with the appropriate authorities.

 12. The Company has not granted any loans and advances on the basis of security by way of pledge of shares, debentures and other securities.
 13. The Company is not a Chit Fund, Nidhi or Mutual Benefit fund/ Society and therefore the requirements pertaining to such class of Company are not applicable.
 14. The Company is not dealing or trading in shares, securities, debentures and other investments.
 15. In our opinion, the Company has not given any guarantees for loans taken by others from banks or financial institutions.
 16. The Company has not taken any term loans during the year.
 17. According to the information and explanation given to us by the management and on an overall examination of the balance sheet of company, we report that no funds raised on short term basis have been used for long term investment.

Note :1

Significant Accounting Policies and Notes to Accounts – 31st March, 2014

A Significant Accounting Policies

a) Basis of Accounting

The Financial Statements have been prepared in accordance with the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in India under the historical cost convention on accrual basis. These financial statements have been prepared to comply in all aspects with the accounting standards notified under section 211 (3c) Companies (Accounting Standards) Rules, 2006, as amended and the other relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 1956

b) Use of Estimates

The Preparation of the financial statement in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles requires the management to make estimates and assumption that affect the reported assets and liabilities, disclosures of contingent liabilities as at the date of the financial statements and the reported amount of revenue and expenses of the year. Actual results could differ from those estimates. Any revision of such accounting estimates is recognized prospectively in current and future period.

c) Fixed Assets

• Fixed assets are stated at Original cost of acquisition / Installation net of accumulated depreciation, amortization. The Cost of fixed assets includes cost of acquisition and other incidental expenses related to the acquisition and installation including trial run expense (net of revenue) and borrowing cost incurred during pre-operational period.

• Capital Work in Progress is stated at the amount expended up to the date of Balance sheet including preoperative expenditure.

d) Depreciation

• Depreciation on Fixed assets is provided on Straight Line Method at rate prescribed in Schedule XIV to the Companies Act, 1956

e) Foreign Currency Transactions

Foreign Currency transactions are recorded at the exchange rate prevailing on the date of such transaction. Monetary assets and liabilities in foreign currency as at the Balance sheet date are translated at the exchange rates prevailing at the date of Balance sheet. Gains and Losses arising on account of difference in foreign exchange rates on settlement/ Translation of monetary assets and liabilities are recognized in the pre-operative expenses

f) Employee Benefits

Payments to defined contribution retirement benefit schemes are charged as expenses as they fall due.

g) Accounting for Taxes on Income

• Current tax is determined as the amount of tax payable in respect of taxable income of the year computed as per Income Tax Act, 1961.

• Deferred tax is recognised subject to consideration of prudence, on timing difference, being the difference between taxable income and accounting income that originate in one period and capable of reversal in one or more subsequent period and measured using prevailing enacted or substantively enacted tax rates.



h) Operating Leases

• Lease of assets under which all the risk and rewards of ownership are effectively retained by the lessor are classified as operating leases. Lease Payment under operating leases are recognized as expenses on accrual basis in accordance with respective lease agreements.
